Recognition/approval of Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla for awarded of MBBS degree granted by Himachal Pradesh University against increased intake i.e. from 65 to 100 seats u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 -Regarding.

I am directed to inform you that an assessment to assess the physical and other amenities facilities available at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla alongwith standard of education held by Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla for recognition/approval of the college for the award of MBBS degree against increased intake i.e. from 65 to 100 seats u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 was carried out by the Council assessors on 11<sup>th</sup> & 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2014. The Assessment report was considered by the Executive Committee at its meeting held on 13.01.2015. The following recommendations of the Executive Committee were approved by the General Body of the Council at its meeting held on 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup> March, 2015.

"The Executive Committee of the Council considered the Council Assessors report dated 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2014) and decided to recommend recognition/approval of Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla against increased intake i.e. from 65 to 100 seats granted by Himachal Pradesh University, Shimla and decided to recommend to the Central Government for approval u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Executive Committee further decided that the attention of the inst<sup>n</sup> to be directed to Sections 8(3)(2), 8(3)(3) & 8(3)(4) of the Establishment of Medical Colleges (Recognition & Amendment), 2010 (Part II) dated 16<sup>th</sup> April 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

8(3)

(2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.

(3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.

(4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute."

In view of above, you are, therefore, requested to issue necessary notification of the Govt. of India recognizing at Indira Gandhi Medical College, Shimla for award of MBBS degree granted by Himachal Pradesh University against increased intake i.e. from 65 to 100
